2006-2007 Uniform Requirements**

PK3, PK4, and Kindergarten Boys

Requirements:

- Red or white SHORT SLEEVE polo shirt
- Navy blue PULL-ON pants
- Navy blue PULL-ON shorts
- Navy blue cardigan
- Navy blue socks

PK3, PK4, and Kindergarten Girls

Requirements:

- White middie blouse with navy ties
- Navy blue culottes
- Navy blue cardigan
- White socks or tights

1st – 5th Grade Boys

Requirements:

- Red or white SHORT SLEEVE polo shirt
- White SHORT SLEEVE Oxford monogrammed shirt (3rd-7th grade only on Mass days)
- Navy blue pants
- Navy blue shorts
- Navy blue cardigan
- Navy blue braided belt
- Navy blue socks

1st – 3rd Grade Girls

Requirements:

- Plaid jumper
- White blouse with navy trim

4th & 5th Grade Girls

Requirements:

- Plaid Culottes
- Plaid Skirt
- White Oxford monogrammed blouse

6th & 7th Grade Girls

Requirements:

- Plaid Skirt
- White ¾ sleeve Oxford monogrammed blouse
- Navy blue Skort

All 1st – 7th Grade Girls

Requirements:

- Red or white SHORT SLEEVE polo shirt
- Navy blue slacks
- Navy blue shorts
- Navy modesty shorts (under jumper or skirt)
- Navy blue cardigan
- Navy blue braided belt
- White socks

6th & 7th Grade Boys

Requirements:

- Red or white SHORT SLEEVE polo shirt
- White short sleeve Oxford shirt
- Navy blue relaxed twill pants
- Navy blue relaxed shorts
- Navy blue cardigan
- Navy blue braided belt
- Navy blue socks

Optional for all grades:

- Navy blue sweatshirt (for PE days only)
- Solid white long sleeve shirt under polo on cooler days

Additional Uniform Information:

- Students are required to wear uniforms to school every day unless otherwise instructed by the school office or their classroom teacher.
- P.E. dress for grades 1-7 consists of the required navy blue pants or shorts, navy braided belt, and polo shirt and tennis shoes. The navy blue sweatshirt with the school monogram may be worn on P.E. days only.
- On all other days, students must be in their dress uniform.
- Boys in grades 1-7 must wear long pants on Mass days.
- The St. Clare Spirit Shirt may be worn on Wednesdays or special days designated by the school office. Spirit shirts may be purchased through HSA. Spirit shirts must remain in compliance with uniform requirements and be in good condition.
- Students are required to wear matching low-cut, closed toe, rubber soled shoes that do not leave black marks on the floor. Platforms, raised-heel shoes, clogs, sandals, boots, or concealed wheel shoes are not permitted.
- Socks must be solid in color (white for girls and navy for boys) and free of any embellishments. Ankle socks are allowed. Girls may wear white stockings on cooler days.
- Extreme hair lengths and distracting hair cuts or hairstyles will not be tolerated. There is to be no bleached, colored, or highlighted hair. Hair bands, bows, and other hair accessories should be conservative.
- Nail polish and temporary or permanent tattoos are not permitted.
- A single watch, stud earrings (girls only), a single bracelet, and a single necklace with a cross or other religious medal of faith are the only jewelry allowed. The wearing of a rosary is not permitted.
- Uniforms must be kept in good repair. Hemlines for shorts, jumpers, culottes, skirts, and skorts are to be just above the knee. You will be expected to make alterations or purchase new items if they get to short. If clothing is faded or dingy, you must replace these items. All replacements and repairs will be taken care of immediately.
- You will receive notification in writing of any uniform infractions. Uniform infraction notices must be signed and returned to the classroom teacher the following day. Corrections will need to be made before returning to school the next day.
- For every 3 violations, a \$10 fine will be assessed. If a 3rd fine is assessed, a meeting will be arranged between the parents, principal, and uniform coordinator.
- Please remember, your child does not have the means to provide appropriate uniform needs. You are responsible for meeting those needs.

Personal Grooming

- The way a student dresses affects the way that the student behaves. In order to maintain an appropriate atmosphere that is conducive to learning, we expect our students to be clean, neatly groomed, and modest in appearance. Hair should be clean, brushed, and secured out of the child's face. Hair accessories must be coordinated with the colors of the uniform. Purses and other non-uniform accessories should be left at home as they tend to become distractions during the instructional day.
